Special Guest


Heinz Strobl is our special guest this year (on photo right at the Masters of Origami, Salzburg, 2005).

7 Contest

The Meeting this year will our 7th convention. So come to us and bring a model related to number 7 (any author, any origami technic).

We also announce a contest for the best model related to 7. It could be 7-headed dragon, heptagon, heptagonal box or a model made from 7 sheets of paper - we leave othe ideas for your imagination.

Rules for the contest

- 1. A model must be related to 7.
- 2. Contest is open for everybody (you may send model also if you do not participate in our convention)
- 3. You may use any number of sheets of paper any shape. Neither cuts nor glue is allowed.
- 4. Individual person attends the contest. Group work is allowed only if number of models in a scene is equal to the number of participants.
- 5. Send your model to Krystyna and Wojciech Burczyk (till April 15th, 2008) or bring it to the convention.
- 6. You must attach to the model a tag (business card size) containing name of the author, country and town, size of the paper used, time to fold and (optionally) the origami organization. The model will be exhibited during convention with this tag. You must attach on the separate page contact information (name, postal address, e-mail address and/or phone). We encourage also preparing short description of a model, diagram and other comments.
- 7. Every participant will receive a diploma
- 8. We have right to publish information about participants and to publish photographs of a model in publications and on the internet.
- 9. he model will be judged by jury selected among convention participants
- 10. Criteria for judgment:
 - Relation to number 7.
 - General appearance and esthetic look, expressiveness of a model.
 - Technique.
 - Difficulty and complexity level.
- 11. Winners of the contest will be announced at the closing of the convention.

How to arrive

Crossing a border

Poland is a part of European Community and a part of Schengen treaty. All citizens of Schengen-countries may freely cross Polish borders, but ID card or passport may be requested as a proof of Shengen-country citizenship.

All citizens of EU countries not belonging to Schengen treaty (UK, Ireland, Romania, Bulgaria) may freely cross Polish borders, but ID card or passport is required on the border. The same rules apply to the citizens of Switzerland and countries of European Economic Area.

Citizens of USA, Canada and Japan may enter Poland without visa.

By plane:

Krakow-Balice airport (KRK) has good connection with European and worldwide airports. There are direct connections with 39 airports including Warsaw (WAW), Munich (MUC), Vienna (VIE), Frankfurt (FRA), London (LGW, STN, LTN) and Prague (PRG). You can fly to Krakow with 22 regular and low-cost lines (easyJet, Ryanair, Sky Europe, germanwings, centralwings). You can also use Katowice (KTW) airport http://www.gtl.com.pl/eng/index.html located ca 90 km from Krakow with bus connection to Krakow and many connections to 31 airports operated by 41 airlines, including low-cost WizzAir

By car:

From west and north - go to Kraków, then follow Zakopane or Chyżne direction (road number 7). In Myślenice at traffic lights turn left to 967 road (direction Łapczyca, Bochnia). After 2-3 km turn right to Wiśniowa. In Trzemeśnia **do not turn left** (main road to Wiśniowa turns left), but go forward to Poręba. Go straight to the last PKS bus stop at the end of valley. Then follow the left road, which ends after 1 km at the gate of our venue.

From south - cross border in Chyżne (national road 7, international number E-77). Follow direction to Kraków. In Myślenice at traffic lights turn right to 967 road (direction Łapczyca, Bochnia). After 2-3 km turn right to Wiśniowa. In Trzemeśnia **do not turn left** (main road to Wiśniowa turns left), but go forward to Poręba. Go straight to the last PKS bus stop at the end of valley. Then follow the left road, which ends after 1 km at the gate of our venue.

From east - follow road 4 (E-40) to Bochnia (about 40 km east of Krakow). When you descend the hill in Łapczyca, turn left to road 967 to Myślenice. About 2-3 km before Myślenice turn left to Wiśniowa. In Trzemeśnia **do not turn left** (main road to Wiśniowa turns left), but go forward to Poręba. Go straight to the last PKS bus stop at the end of valley. Then follow the left road, which ends after 1 km at the gate of our venue.

By bus:

There are direct bus (PKS) connections from Krakow to Poręba through Trzemeśnia. The bus starts at the main railway station in downtown. Get off at the last stop. Then follow the left road (behind the church) about 500-1000m.

You can use also a bus from Krakow to Myślenice, there are several connections by PKS bus line. You can also use small busses operated by private companies starting near main railway station from Pawia street. From Myślenice to Poręba use another PKS bus or private bus. We could arrange the pick up from Myślenice, call us at mobile phone +48/602601719.

- for Krakow: miejscowość = Kraków, ulica = empty field, przystanek = empty field
- for Myślenice: miejscowość = Myślenice, ulica = empty field, przystanek = Słowackiego (Dworzec Busów)
- for Poręba: miejscowość: Poręba, ulica = empty field, przystanek = Poręba Sklep

By train:

Go to Cracow (Kraków Główny railway station). Than use a bus.

Accommodation

There is an accommodation in a hotel (tourist standard) or bungalows. There are 2 and 3 person rooms without a bath in the hotel. There are common bath and toilet in hotel.

Bungalows housing 5 or 8 persons. There is a toilet and a shower in bungalow. Steppe stairs lead to bedroom for 3 or 4 persons.

You will be provided with sheets, pillow and blanket, but you must bring your own towels and soap. You can come earlier and stay longer if you wish.

Cost

Currency

Poland has still own currency: polish zloty (PLN or zł). The major credit cards are widely accepted. You can easily change € and US\$ cash into polish zbty.

At the moment the exchange rates are as follows:

 $1 \, \text{EUR} = 3.54 \, \text{PLN}$

1 USD = 2.38 PLN

Cost of convention

Bed - 25 zł (€ 7,06)per person per night.

Food - 31 zł (€ 8,75) per person per day (breakfast 8 zł, lunch 15 zł, supper 8 zł).

Conference fee:

- 30 zł (€ 8,47) per person for members of any origami association worldwide
- 35 zł (€ 9,88) per person for other persons.

You will pay at the convention. We will pay some advance for you, if you decide to resign let us know immediately to save our money.

The convention starts on Friady, May 2nd morning and ends on Sunday, May 4th after lunch. You may arrive earlier and stay longer if you wish - please mark it on your registration card.
